#### RECHARGING THE YOUTH / JUNE 26 / 2014

On October 4, 2013, the Stavros Niarchos Foundation announced a new initiative, **Recharging the Youth**, to help create new opportunities for Greece's younger generations, which are severely impacted by the country's alarmingly high unemployment rate, exceeding 60 percent at the time of the announcement.
